<p>Rhyming Hopscotch: Use tape to create a hopscotch game inside, or chalk for an outside game. Draw simple pictures inside each hopscotch square. Call out a word, then hop to the matching rhyming word.</p>	<p>Chalk Writing: Call out the following letter sounds: FLG. Write each of the letters 5 times with chalk outside.</p>	<p>Letter Collage: Write the following sounds on a large piece of paper. FLG Collage each letter with different materials.</p>
<p>Playdough: Make playdough together. (See Dojo for the recipe) Roll the playdough to make the following letters: FLGEDCSA TPINMHR</p>	<p>Name Writing: Practice writing your first and surname every day. Don't forget correct letter formation.</p>	<p>Reading: Read a picture book together every day. Ask questions about the book. (Refer to questioning below) Draw a picture of your favourite part. Write a sentence together about your book.</p>
<p>Live Animal Stream: Watch a live stream of the Zoo Animals. Draw a picture or paint of an animal you saw. Write a sentence or a word about the animal.</p>	<p>Rhyming: Glue the rhyming pictures in the matching box.</p>	<p>Bingo: Play Sound Bingo with the Bingo cards.</p>

Questions to ask when Reading Books with your Child

Reading books with our children is so important for their learning. Below are a range of questions you can ask children before, during and after reading.

PREDICTING Comprehension Strategy Questions

Before reading...

1. What do you think the text will be about? Why?
2. What does the cover/title make you think is in the book?

During reading...

1. What has the book been about so far? Does this change your prediction? Why?
2. What do you think the rest of the book will be about? Why?

After reading ...

1. Was your prediction right? Why/why not?
2. What other books could be written related to his topic?
3. What other topics would be interesting to read about?
4. What more would you like to find out about this topic?
5. Did the book cover the topics you thought it would?

MAKING CONNECTIONS Comprehension Strategy Questions

Text to Self

During / After reading...

1. What does this topic remind you of?
2. Does this topic relate to your life? How?
3. Have you seen in real life?

VISUALISING Comprehension Strategy Questions

During / After reading...

1. What do you think the looks like?
2. What do you think the would look/smell/sound like?
3. Were the images helpful?
