I. What has the book been about so far? Does this change your prediction? Why?

2. What do you think the rest of the book will be about? Why?

After reading ...

I. Was your prediction right? Why/why not?

- 3. What other topics would be interesting to read about?
- 4. What more would you like to find out about this topic?
- 5. Did the book cover the topics you thought it would?
