Making the Sound

- /p/ sound is called the "Pop" or "Popcorn" sound
- How: to make the /s/ sound, we need to place our lips together, pop the air and make a short sound.
- If you have a hand-held mirror at home, allow you child to use it to see and compare themselves to your modelling of the sound.
- Tactile Cue: when the /p/ sound is produced put the child's hand in front of their lips as they make the sound to feel the air, ask them "make a pop sound, can you feel the air?"
- When: The /p/ sound is often one of the very first sounds a child will learn. Most children will typically be able to create this sound effectively within the first two to three years.
