

Year 2 Art Activity for Home

Hi Everyone. I am giving you 2 activities to do at home. If you don't have the materials for the first activity, then maybe you can do the second one, and remember, you can always take some paper and sketch things around your home. Just be sure to have made a nice quiet space first.

Foam Marble Easter Cards

Materials:

Shaving Foam

A3 paper (A4 will do)

Food colouring

A shallow bowl (like a lamington pan)

Procedure:

1. Spray **shaving cream** onto lamington pan or similar pan.
2. Level out **shaving cream** with spatula.
3. Squirt food coloring or acrylic paint onto surface of **shaving cream**.
4. Swirl designs into your **shaving cream**.
5. Lay paper down and pat it gently so all of paper is covered on underside with **shaving cream**/paint.

Allow to dry, then cut out eggs to make cards.

Materials:

A4 paper

Pencil

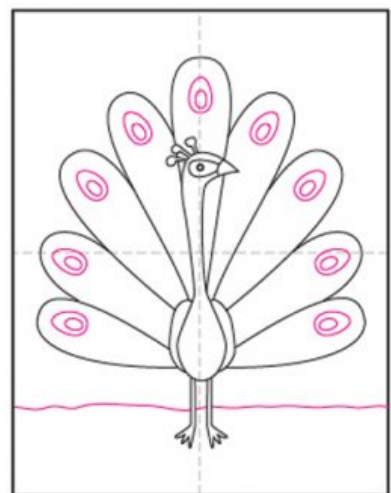
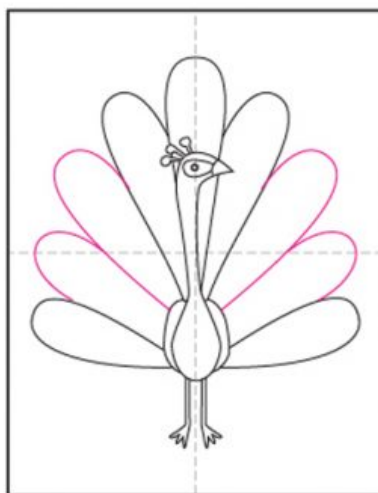
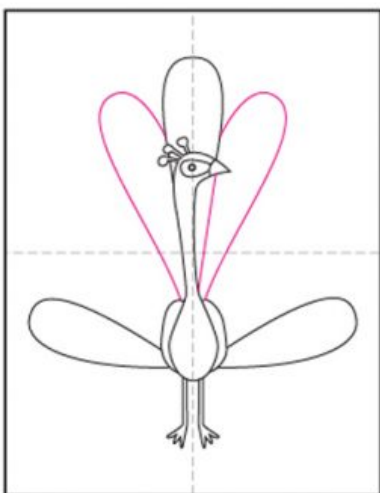
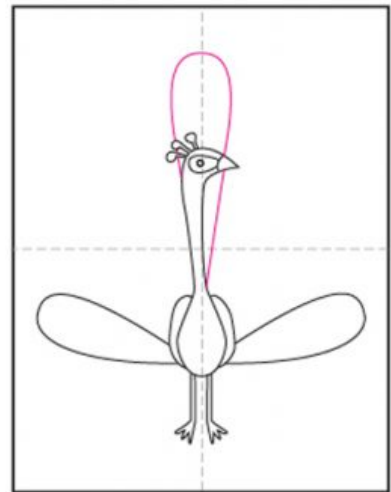
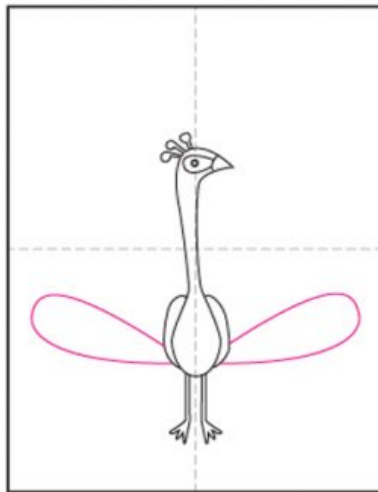
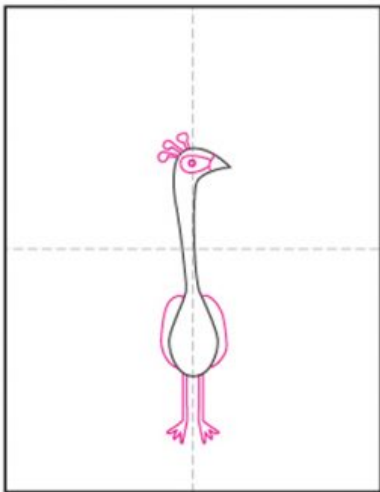
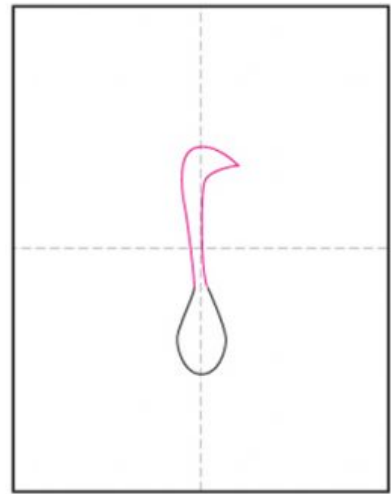
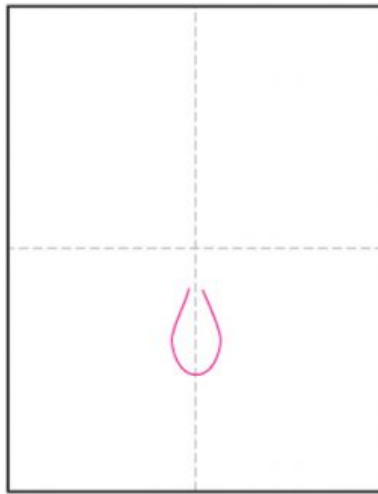
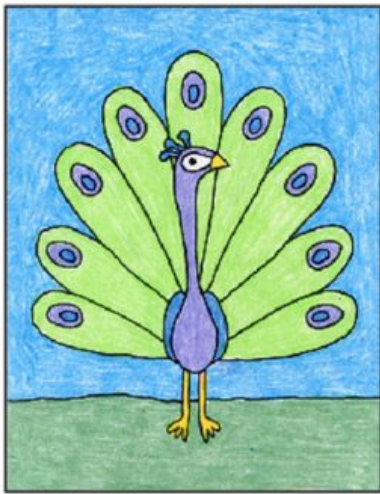
Rubber

Procedure:

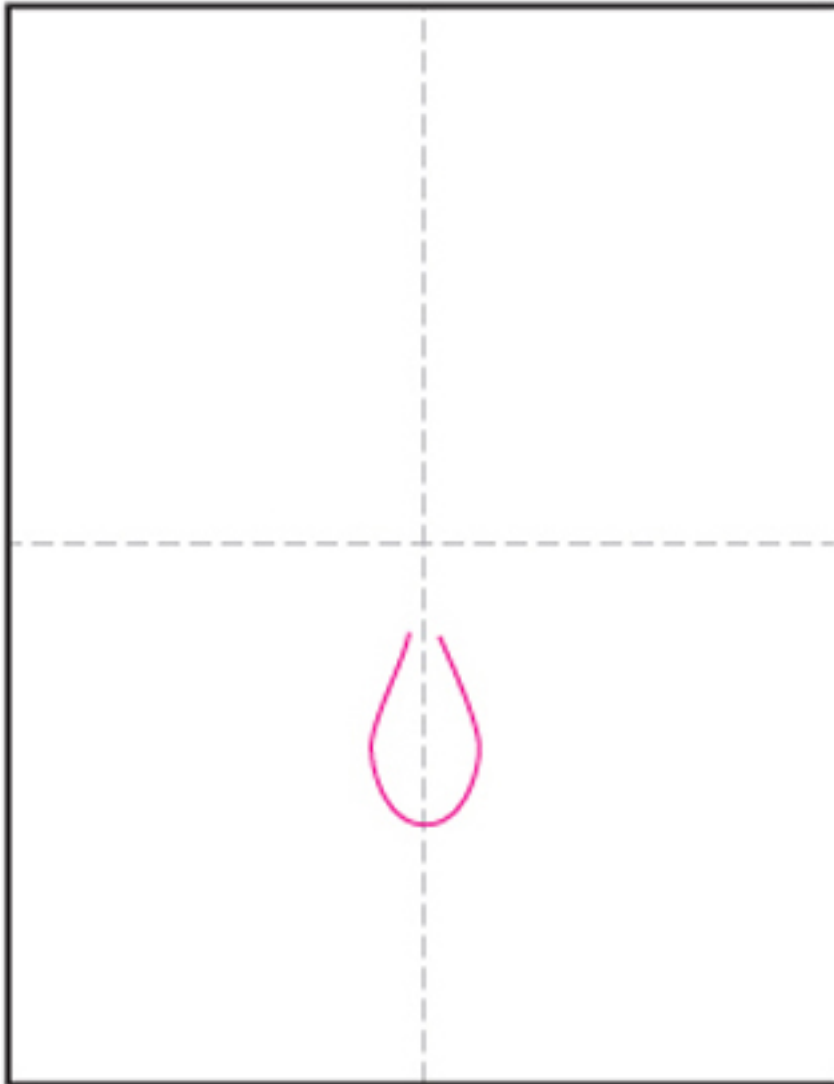
1. Fold your paper into four.



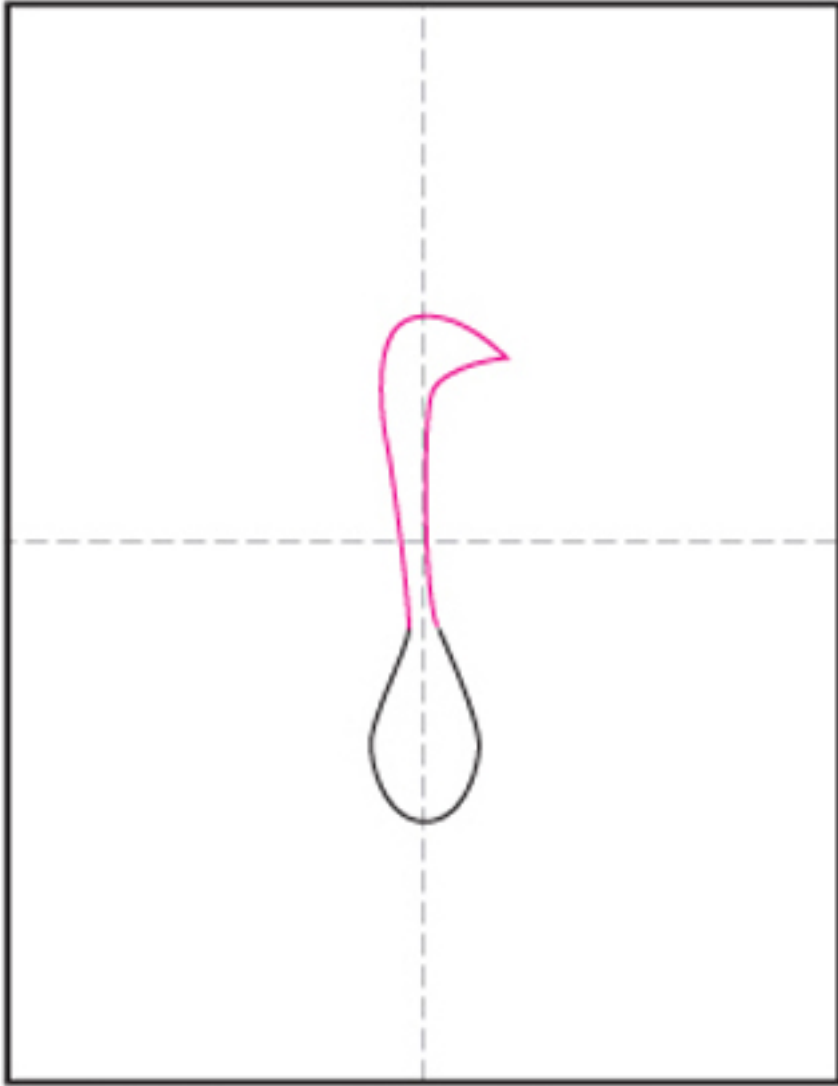
Round out the feathers to look more like petals, and keep the head sleek with a few sprigs on his crown. You'll be left with some very fun shapes to colour.

Another option is to use metallic markers to highlight some details when you are done. They really have the same kind of sheen that real peacock feathers have.

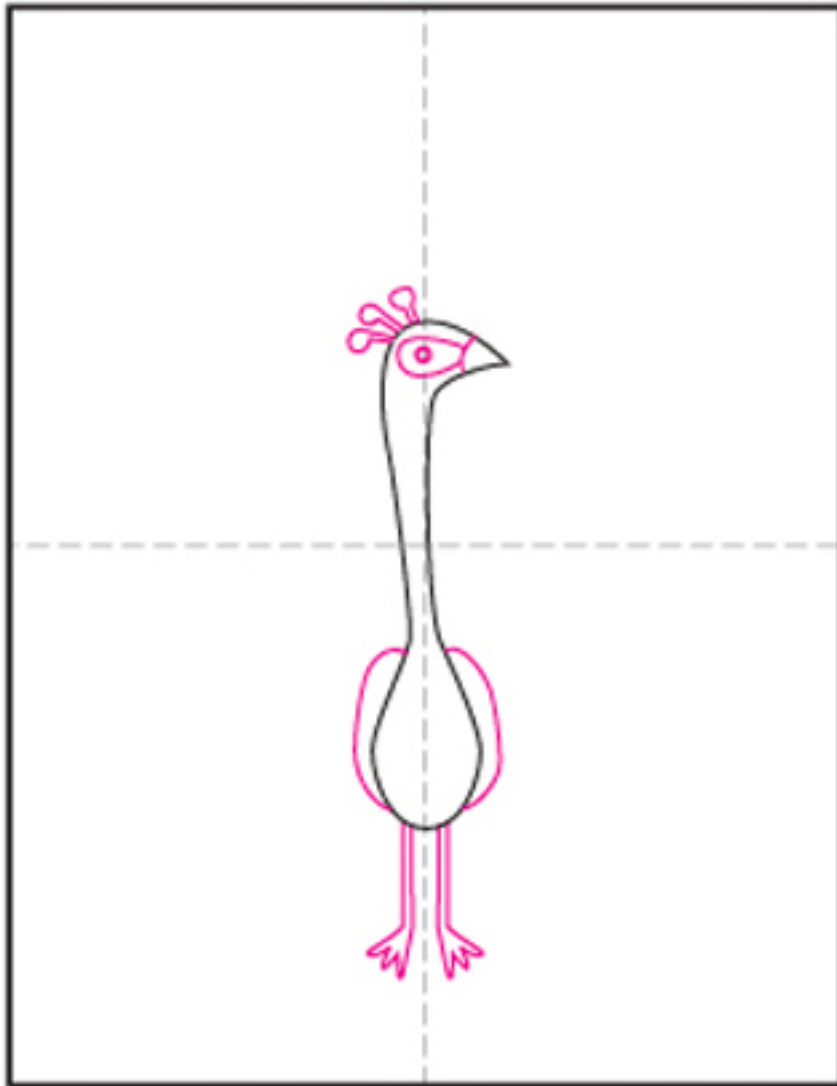
1. **Make guidelines. Draw the belly.**



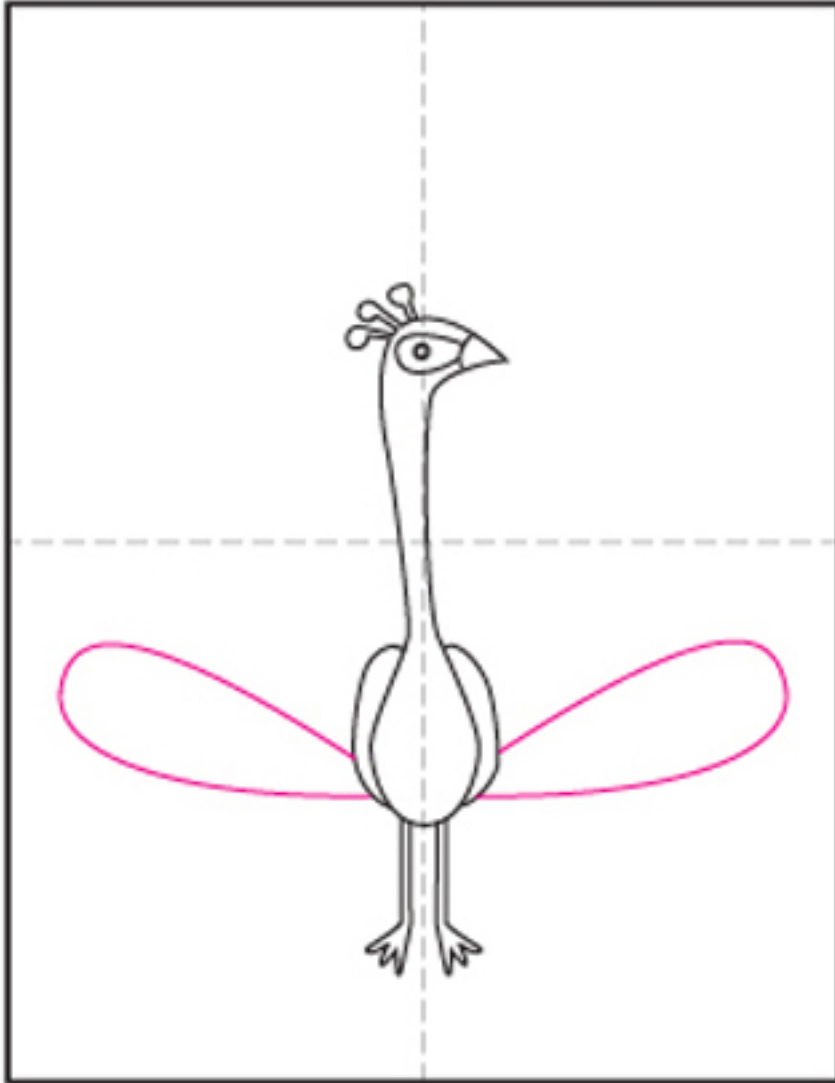
2. **Add the neck and head.**



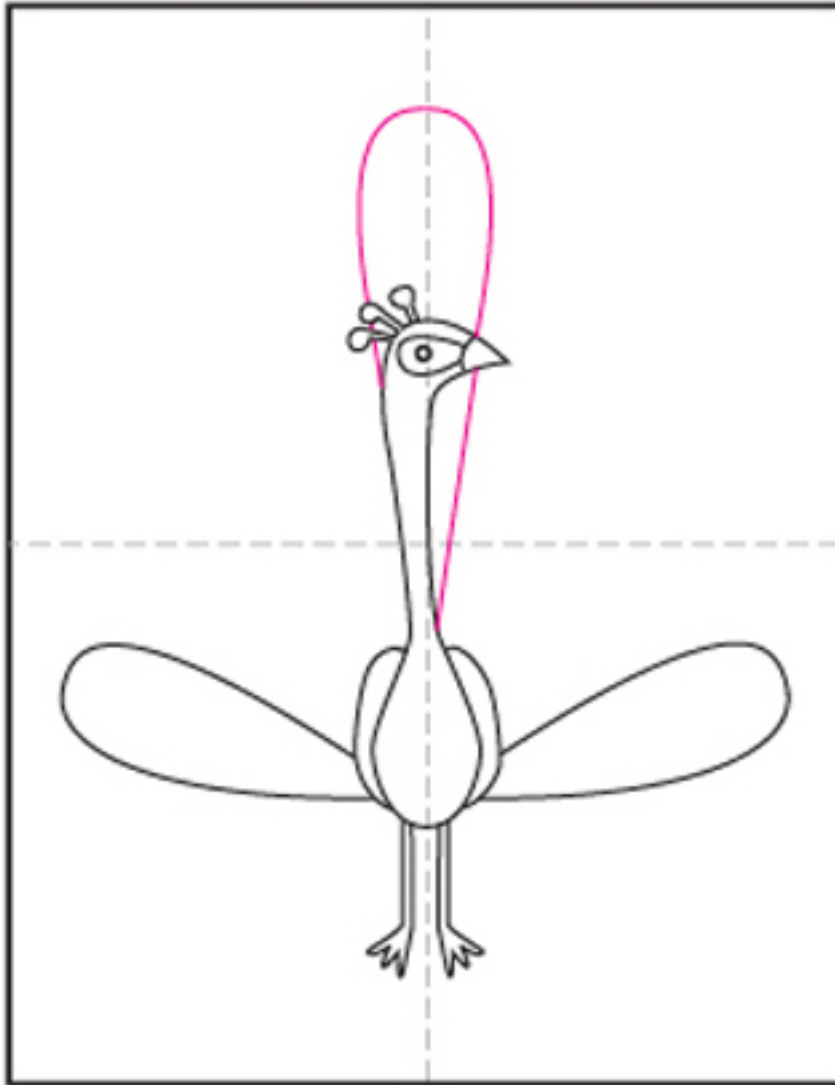
3. Add wings, face and feet.



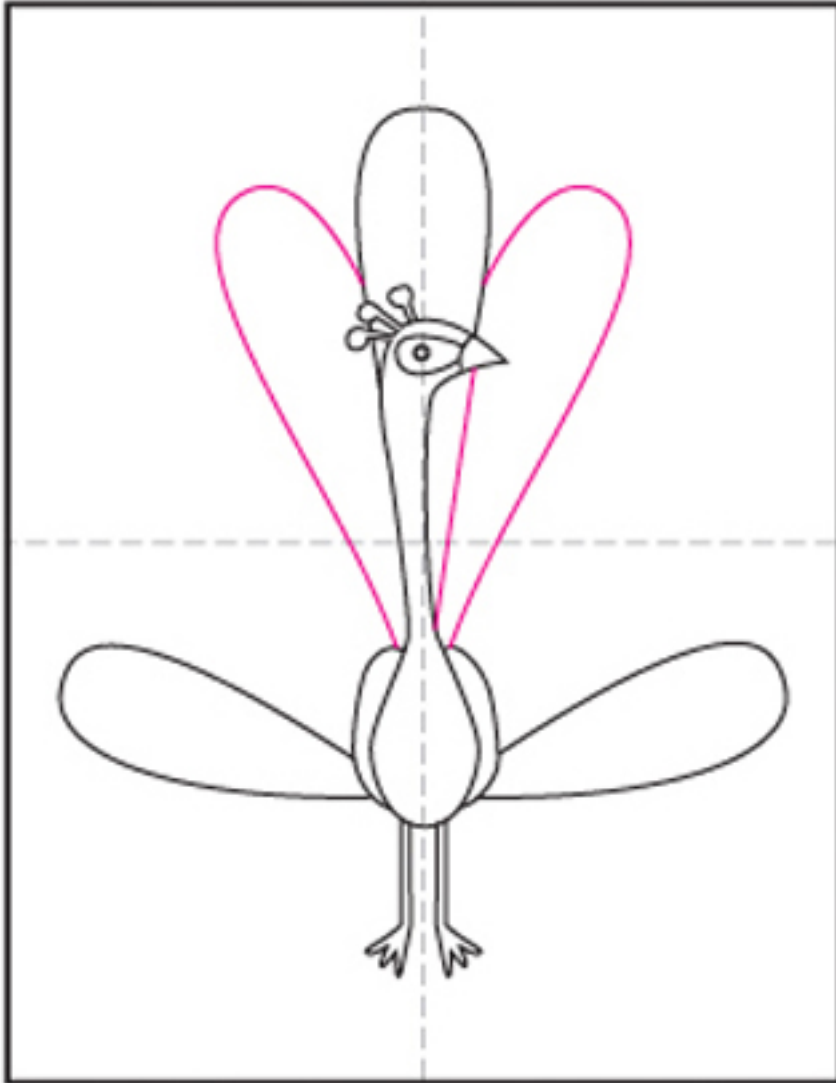
4. Draw two bottom feathers.



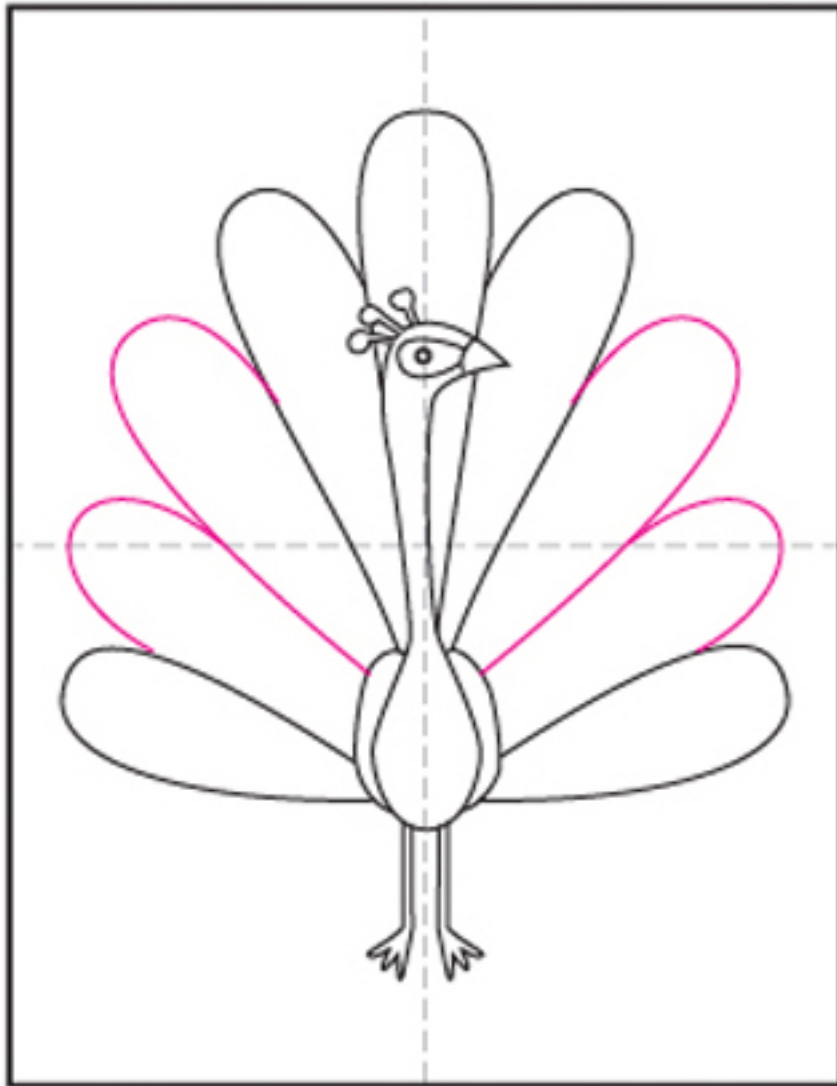
5. Draw centre back feather.



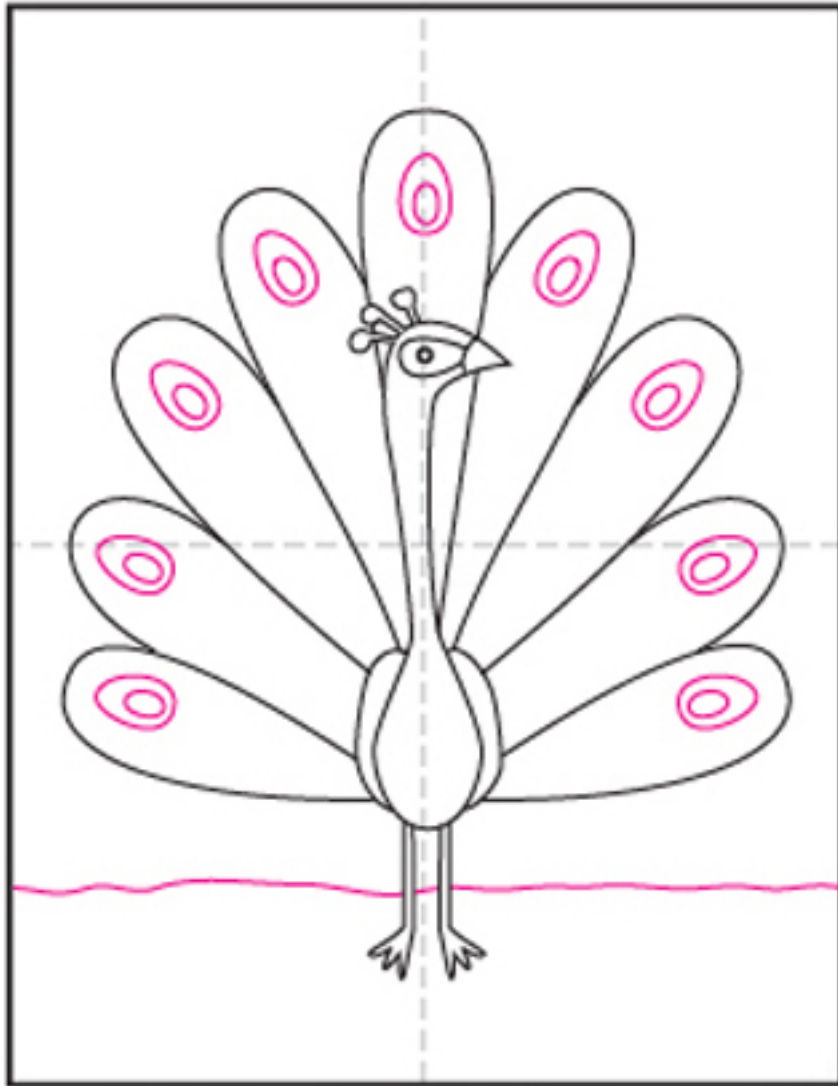
6. Add feather to either side.



7. Fill in with two more feathers.



8. Draw spots on feathers. Add ground line.



9. Trace and colour with crayons.
